

The Dancetheatre Company "Cafe Ada" was created in October 2006 on the initiative of Jean Laurent Sasportes.

In January 25th. 2007 was presented the piece "Autant en emporte le temps", directed and choreographed by Malou Airaudo and Jean Laurent Sasportes together with Benedicte Billiet and Marc Sieczkarek, all four former dancers of the Pina Bausch Tanztheatre. Chikako Kaido and Damiaan Veens, who joined the company for the creation "Autant en emporte le Temps", are young dancers from the Essen Folkswangschule.

In February 12 2009, was presented the piece «On verra...», directed by Jean Laurent Sasportes with the collaboration of Mark Sieczkarek, with René Alejandro Juari Mateus, Damian Schönenberg and Sloogy.

Both of those two pieces have been presented at the NRW Tanzfestival, respectively in 2007 and 2009.

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JEAN LAURENT SASPORTES

Jean-Laurent SASPORTES was born in Casablanca in January 1952.

1970 till 1975: Studies Mathematics, Physics an Philosophy in Marseille.

1975: Breaks-off his University studies and begins to study modern dance in Paris with Peter Goss

He studied dance with Anne Marie Porras (Jazz), Peter Goss, Hans Züllig, Jean Cebron (modern dance), Nina Vyroubova, Suzanne Oussov (ballet). Diverses experiences with choreographers (Kei Takei, Alwyn Nikolais) completed his dancer and teacher formation (French diplom for modern dance teacher). He practises Kinomichi (with M. Noro, founder of Kinomichi and of the International Kinomichi Center in Paris) and Tai Chi since more than twenty years.

Since 1979, solo-dancer in the Pina Bausch company, dances in all repertory pieces through most of almost all important performing events and places around the world. From 1996 and till today, he is engaged as guest soloist with the Pina Bausch company for the repertory pieces (Cafe Muller, 1980, Bandoneon, Victor, Palermo-Palermo, Ancestors, Carnation).

In 1989 he started to work together with the musician Peter Kowald. This collaboration will the beginning of his work in improvisation and structured

improvisation dance. From then on, he developped this direction of work in collaboration with many other musicians as Hans Reichel (Germany), Gunda Gottschalk (Germany), Peter Jaquemyn (Belgique), Tetsu Saitoh (Japan).

Different little dance pieces have been created out of those collaborations, and the repertory is now proposed under the name of "Short Pieces One" and "Short Pieces Two". This Duos work has been and still is presented through many countries around the world (Germany, France, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Grece, Estonia, Canada, USA, Japan).

Since September 1996, Jean Laurent Sasportes works as independant dancer, actor, choreographer and teacher.

 - "Platonov" (A. Tchekov). (2003)
 - "The Cat on a burning tin Roof" from T.Williams ,(2004)
- "Mythos, Propaganda and Catastrophe in the Nazi Germany and the present America", from Stephan Sewel, (2005) as choreographer for Dancetheatre:

In 1998, with the students of the Folkwanghochschule in Essen on a choreographic project, the dancetheatre piece "Wumm Wumm, immer..." will be the result of this project.

In 1999, with the students of the Arnhem Dance Academie and EDDC in Holland" on a choreographic project, the dancetheatre piece "Meeting with an angel" will be the result of this project.

In 2005 Workshop project, "Omagio a Andrea Pazienza" at the Teatro Modena in Genova (Italy)

In 2005 in collaboration with the Japanese choreographer Naoko Ito, for the company "Mademoiselle Cinema" they created the piece "Tokyo Tango" (Japan Tour).

In 2007, he founded the company "CafeAda" (based in Wuppertal, Germany) and created, in collaboration with Malou Airaudo, the dancetheatre piece "Autant en emporte le Temps", and, in collaboration with Mark Sieczkarek, the dancetheatre piece «On verra...».

 - Regularly teaching through workshops in many countries (Wuppertal, Holland (ArtHez), Japan, Toronto, Italy, Spain).

Jean Laurent Sasportes works in his own studio and performing place, "AdaOben" Wuppertal, Germany. He founded the "CafeAda Dancetheatre Company" and lead this company as artistic director; he also founded the "Ikonoclastes dance Festival"in Wuppertal Germany, which takes place the whole season, "First Edition" in 2005/2006, "Second Edition" in 2006/2007, «Third Edition» in October 2008. The fourth. Edition will be presented in 2010.

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MARK SIECZKAREK

1980 Royal Ballet School London Mark Sieczkarek was born in Inverness (Scotland) in 1962 and studied from 1973-1981 at the Royal Ballet School in London. He worked for two years as a dancer with "Scapino Ballet" in Amsterdam, where he also began to choreograph. Between 1983-1985 he worked with the group "Penta Theater" in Rotterdam and from 1985-1988 he was a member of Pina Bausch's Dance Theatre in Wuppertal.

Since the beginning of the season 1988/89 he has been working as a freelance dancer and choreographer. He choreographed for the Folkwang Tanzstudio (FTS) from 1988 - 97. In 1996 Mark Sieczkarek was awarded the Förderpreis of the region Nordrhein Westfalens. The "Mark Sieczkarek Company" was founded in 1998 and after the first retrospektive of his works during the 7th German Aids - Congress in Essen in 1999, Sieczkarek was awarded the Wolfgang- Max-Faust-Preis.

In October 2000 the "Mark Sieczkarek Company" travelled to Accra, Ghana, invited by the Goethe - Institute Inter Nationes, where a workshop was given and the Company performed "Drops of rain in perfect days of June". Sieczkarek was named "House choreographer" of the Ringlokschuppen in Mülheim an der Ruhr from 2001. He returned to Ghana in October 2001 to create the piece "Living with Aids" for the Dance Factory company at the National Theater in Accra. In March 2002 Sieczkarek was invited by the Goethe Institute - Inter Nationes to give a workshop in Krakow which concluded with a performance in Bunkier Sztuki Art Gallery. September 2002 saw the arrival of the Dance Factory company from Ghana to appear at the first Ruhr Triennale in Mülheim and Essen with "Living with Aids" together with the "Mark Sieczkarek Company". It was a cooperation with the Ringlokschuppen and PACT Zollverein, supported by the Goethe- Institute Inter Nationes. In 2002 the piece Macbeth had it's premiere in the Schloß Broich in Mülheim an der Ruhr and in 2003 the Mark Sieczkarek Company and the Dance Factory danced together in the piece Broke which was shown in Accra, Ghana and in Mülheim an der Ruhr.


DAMIAN SCHÖNEBERG

Technical information: Light

The following list is a general list of what we need for this piece in our performance place «CafeAda Oben», but the best is to send us the plans of your stage so our light designer will adapt the lights of our piece to your stage. So we will be able to send you a more specific list of the equipment that we need

Lighting Material: "On verra…" (Fernando Jacon)

24 x PAR 64 – CP62 – CP61. 8 x PC 1kW – With Barndoors. 100 x Dimmer 2,4kW. Light Board, DMX in and out.

Obs. A Light Plot shall be prepaired for the venue. The material list might change.

Technical information: Stage

For the Piece "On Verra", will be needed on stage:

- a normal black dance floor + 2 extra rolls
- 29x chairs
- 6 rectangular tables
- 1 square table
- 1 round bar-table with two hockers
- a low metal garden fences roll (satge bright + 2m.
